HIGHWAYS & OPEN SPACES

On your behalf the Highways & Open Spaces Working Group, is prepared to comment on safety issues and act as 'facilitator' to enable residents to be fully aware of the proposals for the proposed new pedestrian/cycle bridge. This should help inform you, as a resident, in making your own comments when a planning application is submitted.

With that in mind, we arranged a meeting Kevin Day (Project Design Commissioning Manager, Highways Transportation) and Guy Balmer of Cheshire West & Chester Council and have gleaned that a planning application is imminent. The plans will incorporate traffic lights on the bridge and double yellow lines leading up to the Golf Club. We believe that the overall notion of making Chester City Centre more accessible to pedestrians and cyclists is However, at the meeting we welcome. raised a number of concerns regarding the safety of pedestrians, and security and crime impact on the area, etc. A number of questions were submitted to CPRA by residents and an undertaking was given by Kevin Day to answer them. At the time of going to print, disappointingly, we have not received any feedback from Cheshire West

& Chester Council to any consultative meeting.

We have asked that all residents of Curzon Park be advised of any planning application. We will continue to keep you informed by email, if you are a member of the CPRA, and additional information will be available on our website for all residents. Please inform your neighbours if they do not have access to the internet.
